olicies and Procedures

Traditions

1. The General Meetings are typically held in various areas of the GSQA geographic area to encourage participation and access by all members. They are held on the last Saturday of January, April, July and October, but may be moved to another date with board approval.
2. Board meetings are held on the first Saturday of December, March, June and September. Board Meetings are hosted by Board Members.
3. Ideally, the President-Elect should have previous experience as a member of the Board.
4. The current President-Elect will be responsible for overseeing the making of a wall quilt to be presented to the current President at the end of her term. The quilt may consist of small blocks made and signed by each member of the board members. This quilt will be presented to the current President at the January general meeting at which the President-Elect becomes President, immediately after installation of officers.
5. The President will order GSQA charms to present to retiring board members at the January General meeting.
6. GSQA funds are not intended for nor will be used as memorial donations.
7. The Quilt Show is held on even-numbered years and the Seminar is held in odd-numbered years.
8. Free complimentary GSQA Quilt Show admission will be provided for the following:
Children under 12
Tickets will be required by all others.
9. Board Members are required to attend at least 3 board meetings and general meetings each and present a report at each.
10. Check with the Treasurer for information on reimbursement, receipts and vouchers.
