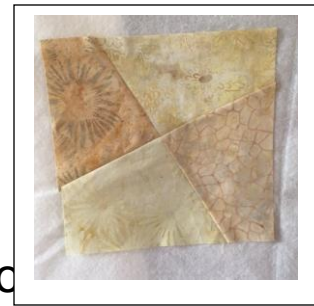


GSQA Raffle Quilt for 2018 Show

construction instructions for pieced background



Use a light neutral thread.

The hardest part of piecing this block is placement. The block can be constructed by using the paper as a template or a paper foundation (shorten your stitch length if using a paper foundation). Lay out the four fabrics on the paper pattern to match the edges of the fabric to the seam allowance outline.



Note how the pins are used to establish the seam allowance for the edges of the fabric. Piece the two fabrics allocated to each paper pattern. Then piece the two two-piece units together to complete the block. Do not trim
