## Starburst Cutting Directions

- These pieces are sized so you have a little fudge room and you will be trimming the extra off as you go.
- The number of the piece matches the section number on the pattern.
- You can cut a strip of fabric the width of the first number, then sub cut each strip into pieces by the second number. (For example, piece \#1 you would cut a strip of fabric 2.5 " wide from selvage to selvage, then submit into 1.5 " sections. Now you have 2.5 " $\times 1.5$ " pieces ready.)
- When cutting yardage for multiple blocks, it's easiest if you use the same cutting method as above. Cut the strips from selvage to selvage the width of the first number, then submit that strip into pieces by the second number.
- Put each cut section into its own labeled clear zipper bag to help with organization.
- Have fun and be creative!
