Rob Appell Bio

My quilting journey began when I started working in my mother's quilt shop, The Cotton Ball, in Morro Bay, California. My wife was working on her teaching credentials so I needed to pick up some extra hours around the shop. Shortly thereafter, the shop started selling Pfaff sewing machines and I became a certified technician for them. I hadn't done much sewing yet, but I was about to!

I taught myself to sew by making about 30 aloha shirts—which yielded a fantastic wardrobe and a ton of scraps, mostly batiks and florals. This large fabric stash fed my desire to try free motion machine quilting and those scraps became my very first quilt. It wasn't much to look at, but my second quilt, "The Dolphin Dance," was a hit! It's an easy strip pieced quilt that has now sold hundreds of patterns and countless kits. From then on, I began teaching myself how to quilt using traditional techniques adapted by me on my domestic sewing machine. I soon became known for my quilted seascapes and people started referring to me as "that surfer dude who quilts."

It wasn't long before I began teaching my self-taught quilting techniques in classes at our store and then at four-day quilting retreats. During one of my trips to Houston Quilt Market I made a wisecrack to the president of Free Spirit Fabrics and landed my first job as a fabric designer! Another wisecrack later and I was designing quilts for Michael Miller Fabric's new releases. I was also offered the opportunity to show my quilts at the Marine Art Gallery. The opening was a huge success, and I was able to sell a third of my wall hangings the first weekend and booked a commission quilt that now hangs in our county's most prestigious health club.

This story travels with me as I present my quilts and techniques to guilds across America. I have filmed for Simply Quilts, Uncommon Threads, The Quilt Show, and Missouri Star Quilt Company with Man Sewing for the past four years. Wow, what a great ride! Now I'm traveling and teaching and developing new quilt projects along the way. Life is short, be creative, and have fun!

I hope you will find it exciting to view over 360 quilt entries; shop in 21 vendor booths; and view the Southern Fiber Artist art quilt titled "MISSISSIPPI". You will notice a few changes to the floor plan this year. In trying to make room for all our beautiful entries some rearrangements had to be made. The demo lecture room was removed to help fit all the quilts. Therefore we will not offer demos and lectures.

In place of 'sit and sew' and a special service quilt making committee, I asked our members to donate a quilt to our service project expecting about 50 quilts. Thank You! You blew me and the Board members away with a total donation of 288 quilts. We are able to provide quilts to 5 different organizations.
