### JANUARY 27, 2024 QUAR-TERLY MEETING PRESENTA-TION BY CINDY GRISDELA





Cindy Grisdela is intrigued by color, line, and shape, just like any other artist. Working with fabric like a painter works with paint, she creates dynamic contemporary compositions, cutting the shapes out freehand without a pattern or template and sewing them together with her sewing machine.

She is known now for her fearless approach to color, but it wasn't always that way. In her early days as a quilter, she made traditional quilts from patterns and was intimidated by color. But gradually she became more comfortable with putting colors together in combinations that were pleasing to her, and started challenging herself to use colors that she didn't normally use. Some of those turned out

to be her favorites.

She adds texture to her compositions with stitching lines. It's that tactile nature of quilts that drew her to creating in this way and keeps her excited about going into the studio every day. She stitches all the lines with her sewing machine, some with freehand motifs and others with straight or wavy lines with a walking foot. There's no computer program or marking ahead of time.

Cindy comes from a long line of women who have expressed themselves using a needle and thread, although there were no quilters in her family. Creating with various forms of fabric and thread has been a part of her life since she was a child, and she is self-taught as a fiber artist, with lots of experimentation along the way with mentors from books. Her formal education includes a BA in Fine Arts from the College of William and Mary and an MBA from George Washington University.

She is the author of Artful Improv: Explore Color Recipes, Building Blocks & Free Motion Quilting, and a new book, Adventures in Improv Quilts: Master Color, Design & Construction.

Registration, categories, general show information, Members' Boutique entry forms and T-shirt orders are just a few things available on the Web site.

We will need a number of members to volunteer to help with the show in many aspects such as docents, quilt hangers, setup, takedown, judging, etc.. The call will come during January and February. Watch both Facebook and the website for signup times. We hope to do this through the website. Without our member participation this show would not happen. Thank you for your help.

We are still accepting service quilts for the First Responders in the Slidell area: police, EMS, firemen, a couple of senior homes & battered women shelters. This year I asked members to help out since we got a late start. The response has been fantastic, but we still lack quilts for teen boys and older males. (These need to be longer and no flowers please). Any help you can provide is greatly appreciated. You can turn these quilts in to Debbie Hulett at the January General meeting. These quilts are presented at 9am before the opening of the quilt show at the Harbor Center on April 12, 2024

### GSQA 2024 QUILT SHOW ROSEBUD LUNCHEON & QUILT SHOW REGISTRATION



Have you registered your quilt show entries?? Registration is now open, but time is running out. The last day to enter a quilt is Jan 8, 2024 either online or submitted via USPS mail. All USPS mailed entries must be postmarked no later than midnight Jan 8, 2024. Quilt registration may be submitted online by clicking on the Quilt Show Tab on the website <a href="https://">https://</a> www.gulfstatesquilting.org/

Please read **all the rules** prior to starting registration for your entries. There is a limit of 5 quilts per member and only a limited number of **extra-large** quilts will be accepted due to hanging restrictions at the Slidell Harbor Center. A photo of your quilt must be uploaded at the time you register your quilt. No quilt entry registration is considered complete until all information is provided, a photo of the entire guilt has been uploaded and the guilt fee is paid. Your quilt does not have to be finished at the time of quilt registration but must be completed before submitting the quilt at intake.

Intake dates are listed in the instructions: April 6, 2024, at the Rosebud Luncheon is the last date a quilt entry can be turned in. Please email Kim Bryson, Registration Chair at kbrys79@gmail.com with any questions you may have. It is suggested that you print a quilt entry form for each quilt you want to register, and complete the paper form prior entering the information in the online registration page, so you have all the information ready to submit.
